



# **About the College**

ouzathul Uloom Arabic College, established before independence, in 1942, is one of the first attempts to educate and uplift the backward community of the Malabar region of Kerala state. Moulana Abussabah Ahmed Ali (1906-1971), an eminent scholar and educational reformist, is the founder of the college. After the completion of education from Al-Azhar University, Egypt, he returned to India in 1935 to dedicate himself for the academic development of the nation. His progressive ideas, concepts and perspectives on educational reformation and his dream to establish a centre of academic excellence in Kerala were encouraged and supported by many. It resulted in the formation of the Rouzathul Uloom (Garden of Wisdom) Arabic College at Anakkayam near Manjeri in 1942, one of the first affiliated Arabic colleges in Kerala. A Committee in the name of Rouzathul Uloom Association was formed, in the year 1946, to expand the college and its functions and to realize the vision and dreams of Moulana Abussabah Ahmed Ali - to build a hub of knowledge, a place from where one can acquire knowledge from primary level to advanced level.

RUA College was first affiliated to Madras University and later with Kerala University. Now it is affiliated to the University of Calicut and Aided by the Government of Kerala. It is included under section 2f and 12B of the UGC in 2008 and has the minority status.



The college offers BA Afzalul Ulama, BA Functional Arabic, B.Com with Islamic Finance, MA Post Afzal Ul Ulama and Ph.D. in Arabic. Apart from Commerce and Computer, the institution focuses on teaching Arabic, English and Urdu. The institution has 18 teaching and 8 administrative staff on the roll. Among this, 44% of the teachers are internationally educated and experienced, 33% are Ph.D. holders, 11% are M.Phil holders, and 22% are pursuing their research. It provides facilities like computer lab, library, network resource centre, auditorium, seminar halls, prayer hall, playground, hostels for boys and girls, rest rooms, wash rooms and other amenities. Various clubs and forums are functioning for the enrichment of curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular potentials of the students.

## **ROUZATH at 2025**

Since its establishment in 1942 the college has covered many milestones in the area of curricular, co-curricular, extracurricular, governance, community services, eco-consciousness and infrastructural developments. Now the institution offers three undergraduate programmes, One postgraduate programme and One research programme leading to Ph.D.

The College has identified around eight areas, viz., academic, faculty development, career development of students, infrastructure, digital campus, governance, eco-consciousness and community service for the improvement and plans to make the institution a college with potential for excellence.

## ACADEMIC PLAN

- Gross Admission Rate: The institution has decided to increase gross admission rate in the coming years, by taking maximum marginal increase in admission, as per the university norms, in accordance with the infrastructural development. The institution has proposed the Government for starting new programmes like B.A. English, M.A. English, M.Com., M.Sc. Psychology, M.A. Arabic, contemporary and innovative programmes, technical oriented diploma programmes, skill development programmes and specializing certificate programmes. By introducing more programmes the institution may be able to increase the students' strength.
- ◆ **Student Reservation Turnover:** Through the convergence of seats other than merit seats, the institution intents to increase the reservation turnover.
- Curriculum: Feedback about syllabus from the students is collected and consolidated, and the report is submitted to the concerned members of Board of Studies. It is also suggested to conduct workshops and seminars annually in collaboration with the Board of Studies, University of Calicut for the improvement of existing curriculum. Presently selected students from our institution are sent with scholarship to countries like Qatar, Egypt and KSA for acquiring higher education.
- MoU: The institution is working hard for signing Memorandums of Understanding and Linkage Agreements with academically well-established institutions from abroad. Through this the institution is planning to begin more programmes, in collaboration with the internationally acclaimed institutions.
- ◆ Innovations in Teaching and Learning: Novel academic and technical methodologies will be implemented for teaching and learning second languages with the support of visiting professors and eminent academicians.



## **FACULTY DEVELOPMENT**

- Publications: The research promotion council plans to conduct series of workshops, seminars and lectures to encourage research activities among the faculty members and research scholars and to publish the research output.
- Part time PhD: The institution plans to start research centers and promote more full time and part time PhDs. The college intends to instil research tempo among the students through conducting series of programmes on research methodology and scope.
- **Faculty Enrichment:** The institution is indebted to maintain quality and hence within ten years all the faculty members shall attain their doctoral degree and within fifteen years majority will have post doctoral degree.
- National and international seminars: The IQAC plans to conduct national and international seminars under each department on relevant areas.
- **Awareness on Intellectual Property Rights:** The college plans to conduct programmes that will create awareness on IPR among the academic community.

# **CAREER DEVELOPMENT OF STUDENTS**

- SEEDS: The project aims to uplift the slow learners to the main stream.
- NOURISHMENT: The project aims to provide better opportunities for the outstanding students.
- Coaching Classes for Competitive Exams: Guidance and counseling wing of the college plans to conduct more advanced coaching classes for competitive exams like KTET, NET, PSC...etc
- **ED Club:** The club plans to conduct entrepreneurship development activities to encourage and prepare the students for undertaking startups, innovative ventures and incubation programmes.
- YIP: Institution intends to be a part of Young Innovators Project to promote innovative skills among the students.
- Certificate Programmes: The College plans to conduct advanced certificate programmes under each department.
- Student Teacher Programme: The institution plans to create more opportunities for the students to become teachers by providing training programmes and live classroom practical experiences.
  - Students' Support: The institution plans to increase the in-house scholarship amount as the number of students intake has been increasing. The institution also plans to make more systematic arrangements for the students to get Government and non-governmental scholarships.



## INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN

- ☑ The institution plans to renovate the existing infrastructural facilities like Heritage building, Library and Auditorium, Garden, Parking area, Playground, Seminar hall, Recreation area, Hostels, Compound wall etc. The institution also intends to beautify the campus by landscaping the courtyard and planting more trees in the surroundings.
- ☑ The institution plans to construct a new building with modern facilities, Amphitheatre, Indoor stadium, Gymnasium, Canteen, Biogas plant, Rain water reservoir, Solar energy, Heritage museum, Swimming pool etc.
- ☑ **Disabled Friendly Facilities:** For providing equal opportunity and the empowerment of differently-abled persons, the institution plans to increase facilities for the differently-abled by constructing ramps, tactile pathways, insight corner, disabled friendly washrooms and toilets etc.

## **DIGITAL CAMPUS**

- The institution is planning to make the entire campus Wi-Fi enabled and to enhance the bandwidth of the existing Wi-Fi connections.
- The college plans to transform all class rooms ICT enabled
- The college also proposes to facilitate ICT enabled seminar halls for conducting academic discourses and faculty development programmes.

- Administration: To make the administration creative and efficient, the college plans to conduct in-service training workshops.

- ☑ Bhumitrasena of the college plans to extend it's services in the areas of Herbal Garden, Rainwater harvesting, Forestation, Maintenance of Eco-friendly and Plastic free campus, Bird Water Feeding, Increased use of renewable energy, Conducting Green audit and Energy audit, and Nature camps.
- ✓ **Waste Management:** Before the end of the next academic year, the institution shall fulfill its waste management policy by making the campus plastic free and zero waste zone through the Installation of Solid waste management.
- ☑ Energy Conservation: Within five years the institution is expected to attain the status of a campus having minimum environment impact, through utilizing more solar energy, renewable energy, sensor based equipments, motor less vehicles etc. Green auditing and energy auditing shall also be done timely.
- ✓ Water Conservation: For the conservation of the underground water and rain water, the college plans to build reservoirs/bunds/tanks and pits for rain water harvesting, and provisions to recharge the bore wells and open wells

- Balsam Palliative Care: The palliative care unit of the college is planning to enhance its services in nursing, homecare, consolation visits etc.
