



Riza, another class representative, delivered a vote of thanks, expressing gratitude to the resource person, participants, and the organizing team for their collective efforts in making the workshop a success.



Research Methodology Workshop on Research Proposal Writing



The induction programme successfully achieved its objective of enlightening the first year B.Com students about the diverse career opportunities in pro- accounting.










Cu TALK




NSKL


related organizations. It is anticipated that the knowledge and experiences gained during this orientation will






Malabar Milma, Peringalam, Kunnamangalam:




Certificate Programme in Spreadsheet Inauguration




The Islamic Finance Colloquium
