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Department of Commerce, in association with IQAC and ED club organized one day Skill Enhancement Workshop on Spreadsheet with an aim to


enhance the awareness on spreadsheet skills among the students on 4th August 2022 at the Informatics lab.

Students gave positive feedback about the programme and demanded for more such workshops to develop and enhance their skills.






Professionalism In Academic Administration




Academic writing in Arabic






Indo Arabic Literature




Inauguration of certificate programs




Seminar on Financial Inclusion and banks




The new generation should apply Ibn Khaldun's social renaissance thoughts - Dr Hussain Madavur




Practice Gandhian Lessons for Recovery of Values - Shihab Thodupuzha (India Book of Records Winner)


