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

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



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Analysis Report on Student Feedback for the Academic Year 2023-2024

Summary of Feedback Analysis

The feedback collected from students across various departments, including Arabic and Commerce, was analyzed to assess the effectiveness of the syllabus, teaching methodologies, internal evaluations, and resource availability. Below are the key findings based on the responses.

Key Insights

1. Interest in the Syllabus Generated by Teachers:

- o Majority of the students rated this aspect as "Excellent" or "Very Good."
- Teachers are successfully engaging students and generating interest in their respective syllabi.

2. Curriculum Update and Relevance:

- Most students feel the curriculum is updated, though some from the Commerce department marked it as "Good" or "Average."
- Arabic students highly praised the relevance of the syllabus, while Commerce students suggested moderate improvements.

3. Career Orientation of the Syllabus:

- o Responses were generally positive, with "Excellent" or "Very Good" being dominant.
- Some students expressed a desire for more emphasis on skill-based learning and self-employment opportunities.

4. Implementation of the Syllabus by Faculty:

- A significant number of students rated faculty performance as "Excellent" or "Very Good."
- A few students in the Commerce department suggested room for improvement in faculty engagement.

5. Effectiveness of the Internal Evaluation System:

The majority of students agreed or strongly agreed that the internal pyaloabon ALY system improved their understanding of the syllabus.
